Popular Misused Verses

2 Corinthians 8:9 is used to suggest Jesus died for us to be rich. **FALSE!**

Philippians 2:5-8 show that we gain *spiritual* riches by his sacrifice.

2 Corinthians 2 is about sacrificial giving, not financial gain. See for yourself!

2 Corinthians 9:6 is used to suggest that giving results in wealth. **FALSE!**

2 Corinthians 9 teaches that generous giving results in God's blessings, not wealth. See for yourself!

John 15:7 is used to suggest that Jesus will give us anything we ask for. **FALSE!**

When we abide in Christ, our desires align with his. God loves to answer our godly prayers and John 15:8 reminds us that our requests should be for His glory, not ours. See for yourself!
