Popular Misused Verses

<u>2 Corinthians 8:9</u> is used to suggest Jesus died for us to be rich. FALSE!
 Philippians 2:5-8 show that we gain *spiritual* riches by his sacrifice.
 2 Corinthians 2 is about sacrificial giving, not financial gain. See for yourself!

<u>2 Corinthians 9:6</u> is used to suggest that giving results in wealth. FALSE! 2 Corinthians 9 teaches that generous giving results in God's blessings, not wealth. See for yourself!

<u>John 15:7</u> is used to suggest that Jesus will give us anything we ask for. FALSE! When we abide in Christ, our desires align with his. God loves to answer our godly prayers and John 15:8 reminds us that our requests should be for His glory, not ours. See for yourself!
